If not, you will want to learn how to machine hem. There are times, however, when hand sewing will work best, such as when you want a truly invisible hem stitch. It takes a lot of practice with machine hemming to get an "invisible" stitch. For a nice, almost invisible hand sewn hem stitch, fold your hem under 1/4" and press with iron. Fold it under again to the height you want for your hem (1/2", 1", 1/5" hem depending on what you are hemming and how large you want your hem.
