Here are our pro tips on how to do just that. Gary Blanchard Scuba diving. Skin diving will allow you to experience the beauty of the ocean in an easy, fast way. Learn the basic Skin Diving Techniques, and start free diving now! The breaststroke is the most useful stroke underwater if you are not wearing fins. When you move your arms from the bottom position at the end of a stroke and back in front of you, make sure you keep them as close to your body as possible, so you don't slow yourself down. If you are swimming with fins there are several finning techniques that might work for you. Novice divers especially enjoy diving in shallow tropical waters to view the fascinating structures of coral reefs and the colorful fish that inhabit them. Visitors to places with coral reefs often can take lessons there and begin ocean scuba diving on their vacation. Some experienced divers enjoy searching for and exploring sunken ships; this is called wreck diving. Professional scuba divers may participate in underwater rescues or perform other underwater work like measuring water quality, filming documentaries or laying underwater cables. Originally SCUBA was an abbreviation for Self Contained underwater diving "also called underwater swimming, swimming done underwater either with a minimum of equipment, as in skin diving (free diving) or with a scuba (scuba diving) (abbreviation of self contained underwater breathing apparatus) or an Aqua Lung.
