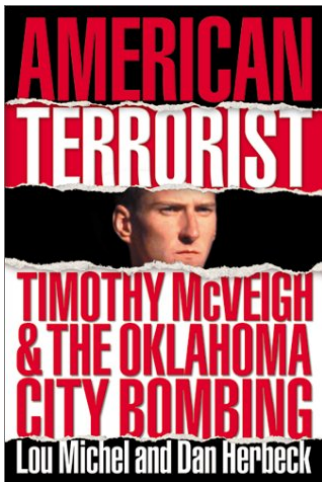

The Oklahoma City bombing is one of the first major news events I can remember hearing about as a kid; although I couldn't appreciate its brutality then, I knew from the look of horror on adults' faces as they took in the scene that it was serious. The bomber, I was told, was crazy. This was an act of violence perpetrated by a crazy person. *American Terrorist* is the biography of Timothy McVeigh, an All American boy broken by war and twisted by hate to become the monster he loathed and thought he was fighting.
