

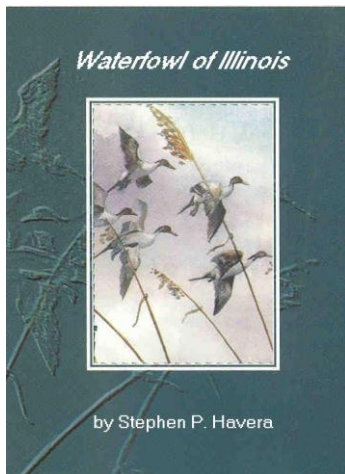

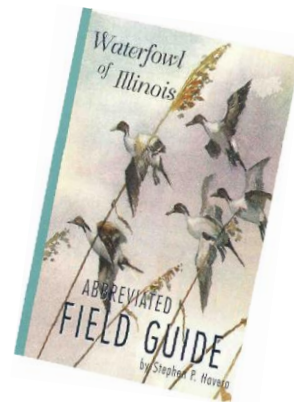

Young mallards are released onto our large water system and are allowed to live "free range." As these birds develop they learn to fly and feed like wild birds. We computed waterfowl use-day (Stafford et al. 2007) and peak abundance estimates for the Illinois River valley (IRV) and central Mississippi River valley (CMRV) and made comparisons between the current waterfowl abundance and the most recent 5-year average. Concurrently from mid-October through early January, we surveyed 60 1-mi² quadrats within the La Grange and Peoria pools of the IRV to generate total population size for comparison with aerial inventories.
