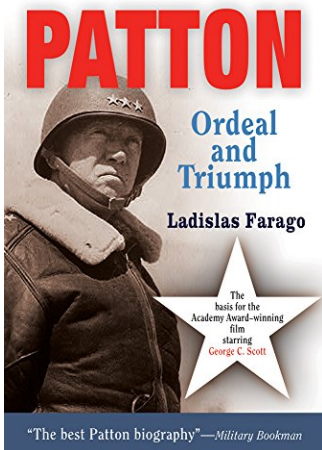

Patton (released as Patton: Lust for Glory in the UK) is a 1970 biographical war film starring George C. Scott as the legendary US Army General George S. Patton, who led the US 3rd Army through notable campaigns in the European theater during World War II. The film was directed by Franklin J. Schaffner (Planet of the Apes) from a script co-written by Francis Ford Coppola , based on the biography Patton: Ordeal and Triumph by Ladislav Farago and Omar Bradley's memoir, A Soldier's Story .
